Competition for School Students Champion Pics 2017

Who can enter? The competition is open to all school students (R-9) in SA.

What do I need to do?

Working individually, students select a shortlisted book from the Early Childhood or Picture Book Categories and create a visual presentation, no larger than A3 in size.

The presentation is an opportunity for students to **show their response to literature: share their feelings** and thoughts about the events and characters, or **draw connections** between personal experiences and the text, or **reflect on the language** used in the text and its influence on personal response.
Students can use any media.

When is it due?

All entries are due by **Friday 8th September 2017**.
The winners will be announced **Wednesday 13th September 2017**.

Is there an entry fee?

Entry is free.

What are the Prizes?

R-2 prize: Breakfast with a South Australian author

3-5 prize: Breakfast with a South Australian author

6-7 prize: Breakfast with a South Australian author

8-9 prize: Breakfast with a South Australian author

Each winner will also receive a book bundle their school library.

How should I submit my entry?

Entries should be submitted by post and will remain the property of the Children's Book Council of Australia (SA Branch). Please ensure that you keep a copy of the work.

Terms and Conditions

1. All entries will remain the property of the Children's Book Council of Australia (SA Branch).
2. Entries via email will NOT be accepted.
3. The appropriate copyright permissions must be sought where necessary and evidence provided to confirm permission has been granted. A proforma Permissions Letter is attached. Entrants are encouraged to use this letter to seek publisher permission.
4. The closing date is **Friday 8th September 2017**. Entries will not be accepted after this date.
5. Winners will be notified by email/phone.
6. Winner's names will appear in our first CBC(SA) newsletter after the announcement as well as on our website - <http://www.cbcsa.org.au>.
7. Entries may be displayed at selected CBC(SA) events.
8. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
